



The American Civil Liberties Union Foundation of Southern California (ACLU SoCal) Jails Project works to ensure that a basic standard of care is provided to people in jail. The Jails Project's Unlock the Vote (UTV) along with other community partners are embarking on a campaign to reduce barriers to registration and voting for justice-involved and justice-impacted folks in Los Angeles County as well as Orange County.

FOR LOS ANGELES:

In order to engage with as many people who are impacted as possible, we need the support of you. We will need volunteers:

- To go inside the jail facilities to educate and register*,
 - Only M-F from 10a-1p
- At the visitors line to educate and register family and friends,
 - Only Saturdays from 9a-12p
- To help with mailings, packets and data entry
 - Depending on interest, this will happen once week during the weeknights between 6-8p
- To attend reentry fairs to educate and register people who are CJ-impacted,
- And so much more.
