What is Prop 47?

Prop 47 is a law passed in 2014 which reclassified certain low-level crimes from potential felonies to misdemeanors. The savings from incarceration costs were invested into social programs, disbursed as grants to 23 applicants across California.

What is JLAC?

The advisory committee is “joint” between LA County’s Office of Diversion and Reentry and the Mayor’s Office of Reentry and is composed of 16 members from county and community entities who have agreed to participate. These meetings are open to the public and are intended to be a space where grantees can benefit from the input and advice of the wider community, especially system impacted individuals.
