PROP 47: REDUCE YOUR FELONY TO A MISDEMEANOR

*Do you have any felony convictions from
2014 or earlier that are drug- or theft-related?
If yes, you may be eligible for reduction*

DEADLINE TO FILE: NOVEMBER 4TH, 2022

Prop. 47 changes certain low-level crimes like drug possession and petty-theft offenses (\$950 or less) to misdemeanors

The provisions for Prop. 47 apply for persons already convicted of these crimes

Petitions to reduce Prop. 47-eligible felonies to misdemeanors must be filed by November 4, 2022

The chart on the next page illustrates several convictions that may be eligible for felony-to-misdemeanor reduction
